Directions to Vincent Ranch: Take State Route 87 to Payson / From Payson, take State Route 260 east to the top of the rim / Turn left at the Woods Canyon Lake turnoff onto FR300 (the rim road) FR300 intersects with FR34, at the T turn right onto FR34 /FR34 intersects with FR75 twice, Turn left onto FR75 at the 2nd intersection/ In less than a mile you will see a two-track on the left, turn left and take the road to the ranch
